SJCCA Board News: Our building had a termite treatment at the beginning of the month. A cursory review of our building's mechanicals revealed years of "band-aid" repairs. Original electrical circuits have been comprised by being tapped into to add additional loading. Plumbing appears to be in the same condition. One HVAC is very old. Although we have upgraded the building's power feed to a 400 amp commercial service, the circuit loading needs to be balanced which has not yet been done. Electrical circuits and devices have been "rigged" and need to be corrected. Lighting fixtures, outlets and switches are all in poor condition and need replacement. A professional building inspection report will be given at the Thursday March 13th board meeting at 10:30 am so that the Board of directors can prioritize spending for areas of greatest need.
