Please join our Century Club.....

Our building is about 45 years old and we strive to maintain, repair and update her.

Built in the mid-sixties, some of the materials used then are now obsolete and require special care to replace. The interior tile floor used adhesives that contain asbestos and although they are safe while undisturbed, they can be harmful if

not removed properly. The tiles have become uneven and bumpy over the years and professionals have recommended replacement (asbestos abatement) instead of laying an epoxy floor over the existing tiles (asbestos encapsulation). Asbestos encapsulation does not remove the old tile, will not create an even floor surface, and places the burden on future SJCCA members to remove them.

Our Board of Directors feel that we need to be pro-active in the renovation of the flooring in the Civic Center. We have received quotes of about \$20,000 to lay epoxy over the existing flooring (encapsulation) but prefer to replace the existing tile with new flooring (abatement). New flooring (abatement) will be more costly but the asbestos tile is removed and the floor will be even.

We are asking for your help to assist us in our efforts. All Century Club donations from 2018 and forward will be dedicated towards the "New Floor Fund". In appreciation, your name and donation amount will be proudly displayed in the SJCCA building. Your generosity and dedication to the SJCCA will always be appreciated by future generations!
